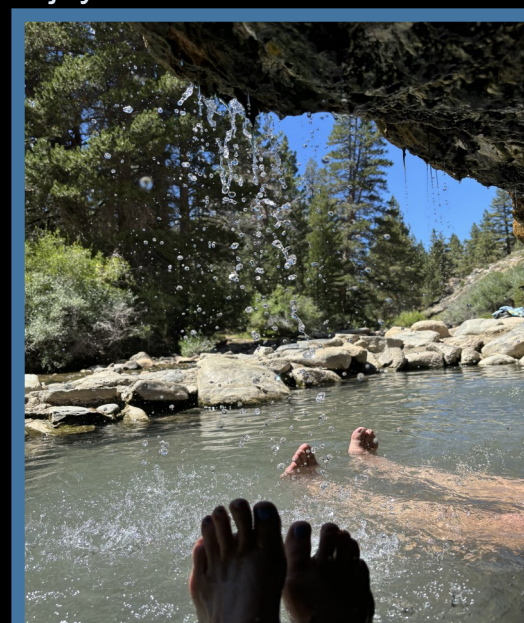
Additional Twin Lakes Photos

August found 18 intrepid SNCKC members and friends camping together at Twin Lakes on the Eastern Slope of the Sierra Mountains. As always there was more good food than could be eaten, happy hour, and games. As well as sing-along and star gazing during evenings that got just cool enough for us to enjoy a little warmth from the fire. In addition, there was wind. LOTS of wind. Day 1 paddle on Upper Twin Lakes the wind and waves quickly pushed the group to the far end of the lake where a “rescue” was staged and people and boats were shuttled back to the put-in via cars. Day 2 only Chuck braved the wind and launched onto Mono Lake, where he had a short, breezy, and presumably fun paddle. The rest of the group fanned out and explored hiking trails, Buckeye Hot Springs, Travertine Hot Springs, Bodie ghost town, the Mono Lake visitor center, Green Creek Road, and in Bridgeport enjoyed the rodeo and milkshakes. Day 3 the group was determined to kayak (this is a kayak club!) and launched early (before the wind) on Lower Twin Lakes for a successful and fun paddle.

4. Submit photos anytime for the website, but please try to have photos for the newsletter submitted by the 15th of the month you are submitting for.

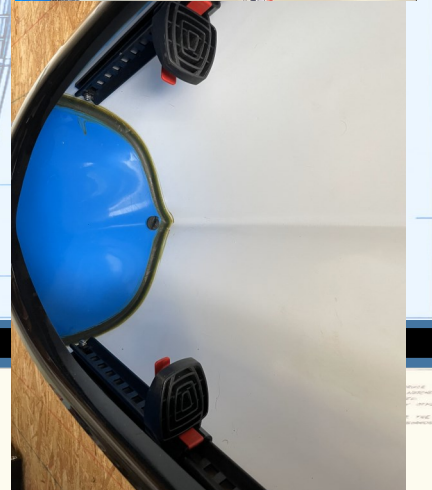
